








Community Development

Partnering with the Cities of Roanoke and Salem, Roanoke County, and the Town of Vinton, the Roanoke Valley-Alleghany Regional Commission successfully received an Urban and Community Forestry Assistance Grant from the Virginia Department of

Forestry to complete a tree canopy assessment for the Roanoke Valley. The final report was delivered from the consultant PlanIT Geo in February. The report analyzes the valley's tree canopy coverage and details possible areas where trees could be planted to increase canopy.
